Nobel Laureate Professor Negishi visits Trinidad and Tobago

On September 23, 2016, Nobel Laureate Professor Ei-ichi Negishi (2010 Chemistry Nobel Prize Winner) called on His Excellency Mitsuhiko Okada, Ambassador of Japan, and exchanged views on academic exchanges between Japan and the Caribbean region.

Professor Negishi visited Trinidad and Tobago at the invitation of CARISCIENCE (a regional network of 12 research institutes in six Caribbean countries, operating under the auspices of UNESCO) and called at the University of the West Indies (UWI), the University of Trinidad and Tobago, and the University of the Southern Caribbean.
