

Broadcasting of Japanese Television Series “Downtown Rocket”

CCN TV6 will start broadcasting the Japanese series “Downtown Rocket” at 9:00 a.m. on Thursday 18 January 2018.

“Downtown Rocket” is centered around Kohei Tsukuda, who was once a researcher with the Aerospace and Science Exploration Agency and now runs Tsukuda Industries, a small factory which was left to him by his father. As the 2nd president of Tsukuda Works, Kohei enjoys moderate success at first, but the company is too cash-strapped to let him pursue the rocket engine of his dreams. Then, everything begins to fall apart. He loses his biggest customer, the banks tighten credit and a major manufacturer files a patent infringement suit of \$90 million, threatening the livelihoods of his employees and the future of the company.
