

Visit by Ambassador Okada to the Commonwealth of Dominica

His Excellency Mitsuhiro Okada, Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of Japan, visited the Commonwealth of Dominica from January 24 to 25, 2018.

During his stay, Ambassador Okada held meetings with the Honourable Rayburn Blackmore, Minister for Justice, Immigration and National Security and Minister for Foreign Affairs and CARICOM Affairs, and the Honourable Johnson Drigo, Minister for Agriculture and Fisheries, to discuss ways to rebuild Dominica as a climate change resilient country, and to advance the friendly relationship and economic cooperation between Japan and the Commonwealth of Dominica.

Ambassador Okada also visited the Fisheries Complexes at Roseau, Portsmouth, and Marigot, which were developed with Japan's Grant Aid.
