Japan's Economic and Social Development Programme (Provision of Japanese Disaster Reduction) Equipment in Saint Christopher and Nevis

The signing ceremony for Japan's Economic and Social Development Programme (Provision of Japanese Disaster Reduction Equipment) took place at 10:20am on December 4, 2015, at the Government Headquarters, Basseterre, Saint Christopher and Nevis. The Grant is provided in order to support the promotion of economic and social development by utilising disaster reduction related products of Japanese enterprises, and is aimed at contributing to the improvement of the capacity of Saint Christopher and Nevis to adapt to climate change. The Grant is valued at one hundred million Japanese Yen (¥100,000,000), or approximately eight hundred thousand US Dollars (US\$800,000).


