**Japanese Government Funds Project for Renovating the Cafeteria and the Retaining Wall for Christian Union Primary School in Commonwealth of Dominica**

The signing ceremony for the Grant Assistance for the Grass-roots Human Security Project (GGP) entitled “The Project for Renovating the Cafeteria and the Retaining Wall of the Christian Union Primary School” will take place at 10:00 a.m. on February 26 2015, at Christian Union Primary School, Roseau, Commonwealth of Dominica. Christian Union Primary School will receive a grant of up to US\$85,693 from the Government of Japan for renovation of the cafeteria and construction of the retaining wall, which will be used for the community of the students of Christian Union Primary School in the Commonwealth of Dominica.
