Japanese Government Assist with Autoclave Procurement to Support Low income Pregnant Women and Their Families



The Embassy of Japan in Trinidad and Tobago is happy to inform that the project entitled “The Project for Procurement of Autoclave of Mamatoto Resource and Birth Centre” executed under the Grant Assistance for the Grass-roots Human Security Project (GGP) has been completed. The Mamatoto Resource and Birth Centre received a Grant of US\$4,795 from the Government of Japan for the procurement of an autoclave in order to sterilize surgical tools.

Through this project, it is expected that the Mamatoto Resource and Birth Centre will be able to sterilize the surgical equipment on site instead of paying other institutions for sterilization services. Moreover, the support for pregnant women and their families, particularly those who are facing financial difficulties, will be expanded.
