Development Issue 1-1 Improvement in Environment and Disaster Risk Management	[Background and current situation] Disaster prevention countermeasures have become an urgent challenge in Guyana due to the fact that the majority of the population is living in coastal lowlands. In addition, from the viewpoint of promotion of urban sanitary environmental conservation, urban environmental management, such as waste management, is required including the promotion of "three Rs (3R)" (Reduce, Reuse and Recycle). Furthermore, in the field of water resources, improvement of the water supply, treatment and coverage of sewers, and reduction of non-revenue water are major challenges.				[Strategy] In the field of disaster risk management, the Government of Japan steadily carries out the Project for the Rehabilitation of East Demerara Water Conservancy and shave the achievement of the Caribbean Disaster Management Project Phase2 with other areas of the country. With regard to water resources management and waste management, the Government would support capacity development of the administration with a focus on training programs and follow-up cooperation while promoting the activities of the private sector. Upon implementation of the above-mentioned support, it is important to keep in mind knowledge sharing and cooperation with neighboring countries facing similar challenges.
