Development Issue Improvement in Environment and Disaster Risk Management	[Background and current situation] Saint Christopher and Nevis is conducting solid waste conversion and will start to build a waste incinerator with power plant funded by UK within 3 years. On the other hand, separating recyclable waste, such as office automation machinery, home appliances, industrial waste and maintaining final disposal site are remaining issues. Renewable energy and energy efficient technology capacity should be developed as they currently rely on imported fossil fuel as their main energy source.					[Strategy] There is a high possibility for their needs in the field of waste management to change due to the construction of the waste incinerator. The Government of Japan will assess the development needs that may arise as the construction of the waste incinerator progresses and continue to assist St. Christofer and Nevis by focusing on training and its follow up in the efforts to address the current needs of separating recyclable waste and maintaining final disposal site. For the other issues, the Government of Japan continues to assist the country by focusing on training and its follow up.

Fisheries also provide the country with foreign currency through export. The Government of Saint Christopher and Nevis considers the fishing industry as an important industry in the National Development Plan, which has a lot of potential to grow and could replace the sugar industry which has already closed its related facilities.				[Strategy] Gross National Income(GNI) of Saint Christopher and Nevis is relatively high. Japan supports sustainable development of the fisheries, with encouraging full and effective use of facilities and equipment provided by previous Grant Aid Project for Fisheries. The Government of Japan keeps in mind knowledge sharing and linkages with neighbouring countries in extending assistance.
