| Development Issue 1 Improvement in Disaster Risk Management and the Environment | [Background and current situation] Although Suriname is a continental country, it is a coastal lowland country and is on the list of SIDS (Small Island Developing States) published by the UN Secretariat along with other CARICOM member states. Suriname intends to achieve sustainable growth by trying to move away from a mineral resource dependent economy; it is therefore necessary to give special consideration to the areas of Climate Change and waste management. Furthermore, it is necessary to promote energy efficiency and increasing the ratio of renewable energy in the country's energy mix as there are frequent electricity shortages outside of the capital city, and there also needs to be an improvement in electricity efficiency in the capital city. In the Disaster Risk Management sector, measures are required to minimize the risk of flooding in inland areas along rivers. | | | | | [Strategy] To cope with Climate Change, both adaptation and mitigation measures will be encouraged through the ongoing program "Japan-Caribbean Climate Change Partnership." In the Environment sector, encouraging activity in the private sector, focusing on increasing the ratio of renewable energy in the country's energy mix, promoting energy efficiency, solid waste management, water resource management, etc., as well as the provision of assistance to enhance the public sector, as it relates to overcoming vulnerabilities particular to Small Island Developing States, will be considered and offered. Sharing expertise and experience and promoting synergy among neighbouring countries with similar problems will be taken into account while extending the development assistance. | | | | | | | |
