During the Ambassador's speech, he shared some exciting news: the Embassy of Japan has decided to invite five judokas to Japan in July. The invitees are BJA President, Prof Hoskins Caddle, Coaching Director, Ian Weithers and three young judokas: Asa Weithers, Anaiah Clarke and Ria Greene.
