(Safety precautions to take during visits in the country)

For all Japanese nationals planning to visit Trinidad and Tobago

On the morning of February 10th, the dead body of a Japanese woman, who apparently came to the country to participate in carnival celebrations, was discovered at Queen's Park Savannah, Port of Spain.

As the rate of violent crimes has increased over the last few years, please minimize any unnecessary night time outings in order to avoid encountering any unexpected threats to personal safety. However, if you need to go out at night, such as in cases of emergencies, please be aware of your surroundings and exercise caution at all times and at all locations.
