Japanese Government Funds the Procurement of an Ambulance for the Libi Makandra <u>Emergency Unit</u>

The handing over ceremony for the Grant Assistance for the Grass-roots Human Security Project (GGP) entitled "The Project for the Procurement of an Ambulance for the Libi Makandra Emergency Unit" took place at 10:30am on August 25th 2014 at the Indira Ghandiweg 432, Libi Makandra Emergency Unit, Wanica, Suriname. The Libi Makandra Emergency Unit received a grant of US\$61,000 from the Government of Japan for the procurement of an ambulance.

The ceremony was attended by His Excellency Yoshimasa Tezuka, Ambassador of Japan to the Republic of Suriname, and Mr. Harty Stanley Dijksteel, Director, Libi Makandra Emergency Unit.
