

JET Programme participants Meet and Greet Session with Ambassador Hirayama

On November 11, 2021, Tatsuo Hirayama, Ambassador of Japan to Trinidad and Tobago, met with the 21 participants of the Japan Exchange and Teaching (JET) Programme who are leaving for Japan at the end of November.
