

Ambassador Tatsuo Hirayama Visits Grenada
(January 17th and 20th, 2022)

On January 17th and 20th, 2022, Ambassador Tatsuo Hirayama visited Grenada and called on Her Excellency Dame Cécile Ellen Fleurette La Grenade, GCMG, OBE, PhD, Governor General of Grenada and Dr. the Right Honourable Keith Mitchell, Prime Minister of Grenada. He also met with the Honourable Oliver Joseph, Minister for Foreign Affairs, International Business and CARICOM Affairs and Mrs. Roxie McLeish-Hutchinson, Permanent Secretary of the Ministry. During these meetings, they agreed to further strengthen the longstanding friendly and cooperative relationship between the two countries, in the areas of fisheries, disaster risk management, climate change and the COVID-19 pandemic and they also discussed global common issues. The Ambassador, who completes his assignment in mid-February, expressed his appreciation to them for their cooperation and support during his three years duty in the Caribbean.
