Development Issue 1 Development of resilient social infrastructure	[Background and current situation] As Trinidad and Tobago is a Small Island Developing State, flood damage caused by heavy rainfall, also due to climate change, has been a chronic problem; thus, there is a need to strengthen disaster prevention capacity. Furthermore, although the country is an energy exporter, production of both crude oil and natural gas has been declining in recent years and the economy has been stagnating, while COVID-19 has caused government expenditure to further expand and public finances to exacerbate. With regard to energy use, the country is also facing the challenge of transitioning to renewable energy sources and promoting energy efficiency along with global trends. In the solid waste management sector, the government of Trinidad and Tobago has been promoting the 3Rs (Reduce, Reuse, Recycle), however, it has yet to be thoroughly implemented. In addition, the vulnerable healthcare sector, which had been exposed by the spread of COVID-19, is also a challenge. Security is also a major issue in the country, with high homicide rates, immature judicial procedures and increased domestic violence against women particularly during the spread of COVID-19.
