Development Issue 1 Improvement in Disaster Risk Management and the Environment	[Background and current situation] Although Guyana is a continental country, it is a costal lowland country and is on the list of SIDS (Small Island Developing States) published by the UN Secretariat along with the other CARICOM member states. Taking Climate Change into account, disaster risk reduction measures have become an urgent need in Guyana due to the fact that the majority of the population lives in the coastal lowlands. In addition, increasing the ratio of renewable energy in the country's energy mix and promoting energy efficiency are required to address energy issues such as loss in power distribution and high electricity rates. Urban environmental management, such as solid waste management, including the promotion of 3Rs (Reduce, Reuse and Recycle), is also required from the viewpoint of promoting urban sanitary environmental conservation. Furthermore, in the field of water resources, improvement in the rate of water treatment and sewerage coverage, and the reduction of non-revenue water are major challenges.				measures will be encouraged through the ongoing program "Japan-Caribbean Climate Change Partnership."
